POSITIVES

- □ Keeps La Mesa/Chamberino intact
- □ Still moves Del Cerro to Mesquite (closer)
- Still reduces Berino and Mesquite Elementaries
- □ Can put NNE at similar enrollment to MES, BES
- □ Takes into account developments along Westside Road and adds to La Union
- Slows Santa Teresa Elementary growth

NEGATIVES

- □ Reduces San Miguel to small K-6 school (can they support programs-music-art-computers, etc.)
- □ Increase administrative/clerical costs at San Miguel in light of new elementary
- □ Increases construction costs by \$1.5-\$3.0 million
- □ Are we maximizing facility usage to justify future state funding requests????
