PROPOSED ACADEMIC CALENDAR POLICY

SCHOOL BOARD

The Academic Calendar

Purpose: The Gadsden Independent School District will follow specific criteria to develop the academic calendar for traditional and continuous schools.

Participants: The district calendar committee.

Process:

- A. The district academic calendars will consist of 182 contract days of which 91 days will be prior to January 1st and 91 days will be after January 1st.
- B. The district academic calendars will include 6 instructional preparation days.
- C. The district academic calendars will consist of no less than 176 days of instruction for students in grades 1st through 12th.
- D. The district academic calendars will consist of no less than 172 days of instruction for kindergarten students.
- E. The district academic calendars will include one Parent/Teacher Conference day within the first six weeks of each semester. The Parent/Teacher Conference days will count as instructional days.
- F. School will not be in session on the following holidays:
 - □ Fourth of July
 - Labor Day
 - □ Thanksgiving Day including the preceding Wednesday and the following Friday (3 days)
 - □ Christmas/New Years (minimum of 10 week days)
 - □ Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
 - □ President's Day
 - Good Friday and the Monday after Easter
 - Memorial Day
- G. At the end of the fall intersession (continuous schools) there will be a one-week fall break for all schools.
- H. A one-week spring break will follow the two weeks of State testing.

Timeline:

The enforcement of this policy is ongoing.
