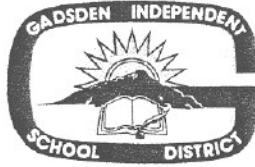

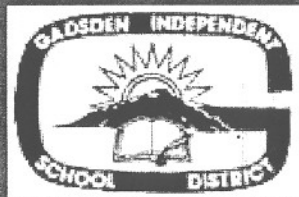

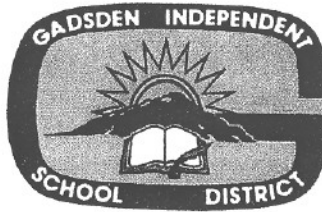

The District wishes to inform you of this decision with enough advance notice in order to allow you to make any necessary accommodations for the 2005/2006 school year.

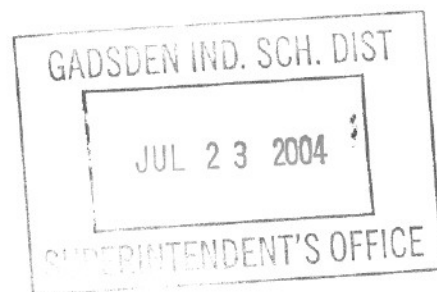


It is with great pleasure that I write to inform you that you have been selected as the recipient of the 2005 NMMEA School Administrator Award.

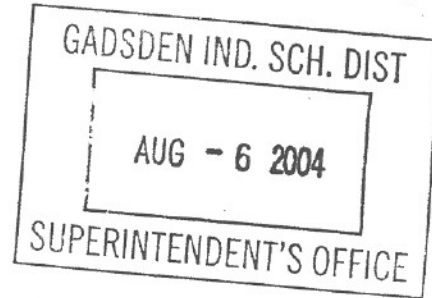
