

I am pleased to announce the opportunity for continuation and expansion of the Full Day Kindergarten Plus Pilot Project currently being implemented in your district. As you know, this pilot project is designed to examine the efficacy of an extended kindergarten program for students most in need.

House Bill 43, sponsored by Representative Mimi Stewart, was passed by the 2006 Legislature and signed into law by Governor Richardson. This legislation extends the original 3-year kindergarten plus pilot project to a 6-year study ending in 2009. House Bill 43 also provides for expansion of the project in the four original pilot school districts (Albuquerque, Gadsden, Gallup-McKinley and Las Cruces). In accordance with this legislation, Gadsden Independent Schools may expand the kindergarten plus program by adding additional classes or schools or both.

Gadsden Independent Schools may apply for continuation and/or expansion funding up to \$200,000.00. Existing full-day kindergarten programs may be extended by a minimum of forty instructional days and up to a maximum of four months. Funding will be available upon approval of your district's application and will continue through June 30, 2007.

Your district's application may be submitted at any time between April 5 and May 19, 2006, but no later than close of business on May 19, 2006. Applications will be reviewed upon receipt and funds will be awarded upon approval.
