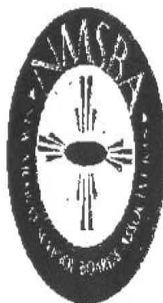

## SUMMARY

or up to two NMSBA Online Learning Courses - when completed with a final exam score of 80% or better, certificates of completion are awarded

NMSBA - Trainings conducted by NMSBA representatives on-site at districts

2006 Spring Region Meetings - One hour training session with prior approval

2006 NSBA Annual Convention - April in Chicago, IL (up to 3 hours)
