

Dear Dr Mora:

The Technology for Education Act requires annual review and approval of a school district educational technology plan and requires every school district to "file a report with the department of education regarding distributions received, expenditures made and educational technology obtained by the district and such other related information as may be required by the department of education." (NMSA 22-15A-10). Congratulations! Your technology report has been approved.

Based on available funding, your initial budget for your district is:

<u>District to be served</u> Gadsden Independent Schools 90% Allocation \$193,294

On or before January 3, 2007 your district will receive a final adjusted budget. These funds will be reimbursed and must be expended or encumbered in accordance with legislative language.

In order to budget these funds, please submit a signed Budget Adjustment Request (BAR) in the amount of \$193,294 utilizing Fund Code 27117 and Revenue Code: 43202. Because in some cases grant requests have been modified, please submit the attached budget and justification form describing the use of funds along with the BAR.
