FINAL ALLOCATION FOR SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION – SCHOOL YEAR 2006-2007

Attached is the 2006-2007 operating formula for school transportation, which is based on the information provided on the 40th day report and adjusted for special education students on the December 1st count from your district. The students in special education counted for this school year were identified in the district's STARS report that have a current IEP and are in level 4 and the students at age 3 & 4. The operating formula does not include the funding for equipment (i.e., rental fees for school bus contractors and/or for school owned bus purchases).
