PNM CLASSROOM INNOVATION GRANT AGREEMENT

The PNM Fund, a division of the PNM Resources Foundation has approved a PNM Classroom Innovation Grant of \$2,500.00 to Desert Trail Elementary ("School") and Mr. Joseph Patrick Ramirez (collectively with School, "Grantee") for the purpose of "P.A.C.-R.A.T.T.
