Dear Superintendent Nava,

We are pleased to inform you that the Public School Capital Outlay Council (PSCOC) has approved an award up to \$192,833.55 to your District to assist in developing a five-year facilities master plan (FMP) with a local match requirement of \$21,425.95. A five-year FMP is required for PSCOC funding consideration under the standards-based capital outlay process.

This funding is financed through supplemental severance tax bonds, and availability of these funds is contingent upon several bond sales throughout the fiscal year by the State Board of Finance. Please note that the award can be used only for the development of the district's five-year facilities master plan and requires matching local funds (see attached).

Prior to the expenditure or draw down of any state awarded funds, the district must submit signed copies of all contracts and supporting documents to the Public School Facilities Authority for approval. The PSCOC directs the districts to follow and meet the most recent "School District Facilities Master Plan Components and Guidelines". All projects shall utilize standard contracts, procedures, and reporting requirements as defined by the PSFA. The PSFA will hold 20% of total award amount until the completed FMP is reviewed and approved by the PSFA.


## Deadline for the acceptance of this grant is December 18, 2009.
