It is a pleasure to inform you that we have approved your proposal for the 2010 NM GEAR UP Summer Credit Recovery Program at Chaparral High School. Statement of Work

The district will be responsible for providing a summer credit recovery program at Chaparral High School to assist up to 210 NM GEAR UP students who have failed at least one required course during the previous year. Upon successful course completion and a minimum of 60 class hours of participation, students will be awarded one full credit in one or more of the following courses:

- Algebra 1
- Geometry
- English 1
- English 2
- · U.S. History/Geography
- · Government/Economics
- Integrated Science

The students will be provided direct instruction in the above content areas. Curriculum will address mastery of grade level appropriate New Mexico Standards and Benchmarks.

a. Number of Sessions

There will be one six week session.

b. Session Dates

The camp will take place from May 24 through July 1, 2010.

Chaparral High School

d. Capacity

Capacity per course is 30 students for a program total of 210 students
