SUBJECT: Education Jobs Fund Information and Allocations for FY12

The Education Jobs Fund Program that was awarded to New Mexico in the 2010-2011 school year was a great success. The United State Federal Government has awarded New Mexico an additional \$958,216 from the Education Jobs Fund Program. The Code of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number for the Education Jobs fund is 84.410A

In accordance with the requirements of this program, these funds must be allocated through the public school funding formula in the same manner as the original allocation. The allocations are attached and are based on the 2010-2011 final funded units used during FY11.

The additional funds may be utilized in the same manner as the initial allocation from 2010-2011. Jobs funded under this program include those that provide educational and related services for early childhood, elementary, and secondary education at the school level. District level jobs are not eligible for this funding. LEA's are not required to submit an application to receive these supplemental funds.

Based on information provided from the Federal program office, these funds must comply with the Cash Management Improvement Act (CMIA). Therefore, these funds will be disbursed on a reimbursement basis. In order to receive your reimbursement, you must upload your monthly expenditures in OBMS using in the existing Education Jobs fund number 25255.

The required reporting requirements for these funds and associated work hours will be handled through the Certiclear system. Hours must be entered into the certiclear system in a timely manner.

Please prepare a BAR for the amount on the enclosed spreadsheet using fund code 25255 and revenue code 44301 and submit to your budget analyst as soon as possible. These funds remain available for obligation through September 30, 2012. However, we strongly encourage you to expend these funds in 2011-2012.
