

Synopsis of the Title I Part C (Migrant) Program for 2016-2017

Gadsden Independent School District School Board Meeting May 26,, 2016

The **Title I Part C** allocation for 2016-17 is \$123,592. As you know, this budget provides supplies and services to eligible migrant students and their families.

In SY 16-17, the Migrant budget will continue to provide professional support for teachers through the Federal Programs Coordinator and 6 of the district's Instructional Coaches. For the coming school year the Title II Budget will continue to provide the following additional instructional support for teachers and administrators:

- Stipends for after school tutoring for Priority of Service Migrant students in reading and math.
- Instructional supplies that may be needed by after-school tutors.
- Stipends for student/family mentor services designed to help students and families bridge the gap that may exist between the home and school.
- School supplies and uniforms for migrant students.
- Professional development for staff members who serve migrant families to bring providers to a deeper understanding of the migrant culture and any barriers that may prevent student success in school.

I am respectfully requesting authorization for the Superintendent or his designee to sign and submit the Title I Part C (Migrant) application to the New Mexico Public Education Department upon completion and prior to the due date on May 30, 2016
