Whereas, the total cost of the project will be \$35,112.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$26,334.00
- b. Gadsden Independent School District's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$8,778.00

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$35,112.00

Gadsden Independent School District shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$35,112.00.

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that Gadsden Independent School District determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2022 and Gadsden Independent School District incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW therefore, be it resolved by the Gadsden Independent School District to enter into Cooperative Agreement Control Number **HW2 L100466** with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project for the 2020 – 2021 to "design and construct the existing gravel bus route including processing existing crusher base course, prime coat and 3" PMBP paving at – **Chaparral High School**, 800 County Line Drive, Chaparral, NM." within the control of the Gadsden Independent School District in Dona Ana, New Mexico.
