- Due to the COVID-19 alleviation measures approved by the U.S. congress through the CARES Act, the FY18-19 redistribution and carryover amounts have been granted a time extension of an additional 12 months. The FY18-19 redistribution and carryover amounts indicated above must be expended by September 30, 2021. Please keep in mind that funding is applied by sourcing the oldest grant first and the newest grant last (first in, first out) method.
- Pursuant to NMSA 6-5-3, the appropriate fund shall be encumbered prior to the issuance of vouchers or purchase orders or the engagement of contracts.
