Background and Summary:

HB 236, referred to as the Attendance for Success Act (54<sup>th</sup> Legislature, First Session, 2019), repeals and replaces the New Mexico Compulsory School Attendance Law. The titles of Policy JHB, Regulation, and Exhibits have been altered to reflect the change from tracking only unexcused absences, known as truancy, to the requirements for tracking all chronic absences regardless of being excused or unexcused. The policy provides the directions for handling chronic and unexcused absences, how interventions are to be implemented and what will result upon a lack of success with the interventions. The Regulation indicates record-keeping requirements for all absences and what parents may request in the way of attendance data with timelines. The Exhibits include some of the interventions the district may use with absent or chronically absent students. A form letter is also included that may be used by the District to contact parents and record actions taken with a student. Detailed instructions are included for developing Attendance Improvement Plans and whole school prevention strategies.
