Introduction And Roll Call	 The Gadsden School Board convened in regular session at 5:00 p.m. President Viramontes presided at the meeting held virtually at the Gadsden Administrative Complex. Members present: Armando Cano, Daniel Castillo, Laura Salazar Flores, Claudia Rodriguez, and Jennifer Viramontes.
Pledge & Mission Statement	 The Pledge of Allegiance and the Pledge to the New Mexico flag was led by Alexis Holguin and Karime Gonzalez. Claudia Rodriguez read the mission statement.
Superintendent's Report	 Superintendent District Updates and Recognitions: A. Mrs. Coyle, Principal at Vado Elementary School, presented a virtual learning highlight video. The video highlights two students, Alexis Holguin and Ralph Juarez singing to Karaoke, Art Work created by Mr. Santa Maria's virtual learning Art Classes. It also highlights students from Mrs. Ramos Kinder class sharing their class projects and Mrs. Cortez's 4th grade class using the book "One Grain of Rice" as a math lesson. In addition, there are some highlighting pictures from Mrs. Lucero's students in her Developmental Skills Class sharing the project they have been working on.
