Criteria to Participate in Online Instruction for the 2021-22 school year

With a year offering the remote/ online platform to deliver instruction we have some data to help guide the development of a criteria for students to select this as their primary learning option.

- Student attendance rate must be a 94% or higher based on the 2020-21 school year
- Student must have passed all classes with a "C" or higher based on their report card from the 2020-21 school year
- Secondary Students must be on track to graduate based on credits earned as of August 2021
- Students and families must agree that all federal, state, and district level assessments must be taken in person
- Parent(s)/ Guardian(s) must be able to confirm high speed internet accessibility is available in their home
- Student understands that attendance in class will be determined by their presence meaning camera and audio is on at all times (teaches can allow students to turn off camera if needed to maintain internet connection)
- Medical Exemptions can be allowed based on doctor's notes to include specific medical conditions as well as vaccination status
